Finance Details

Research Stays

- So far 12 PhD students used the funding
- There is still plenty of room for more, but research stays should take place in 2019
- We are not very strict on requirements
- Remaining funding will be used for Final Symposium (invited guest)

Guest funding:

- Similar to 2018: FCFS
- No default transfer
- Short informal mail with cost estimation
- If every project applies: 1700€ per project

Workshops:

- There will be one last call for workshops in May 2019
- Workshops should take place in 2019



Final Symposium

- Oct 21-23, 2019 in Dresden
- Current planning: Monday noon till Wednesday evening
- One minisymposium per project with 4 speakers:
 - Ideally: 2 internals, 2 externals
 - Ideally: At least 1 of 2 externals is international
 - Ideally: At least 1 of 2 externals is a woman
- There will be central funding to invite the externals, exact amount and procedure will be announced in spring



Proceedings

- Springer LNCSE
- One longer (review) paper per project
- Focus on Phase 2, but also overview of Phase 1+2
- Special (optional) section: influence of international phase
- Serves as final DFG project report
- External speakers can also contribute papers (please ask them)
- Rough schedule:
 - Announcement and CfC: spring 2019
 - Submission deadline: August 2019
 - Review deadline: October 2019
 - Publishing: 2020
